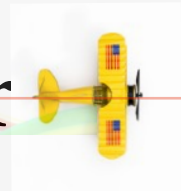

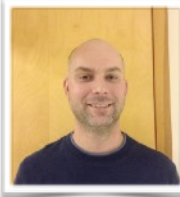

Plow Award: This month Mike Coyne wins for having broken three aircraft in less than one hour out at Henry's church for the chili supper, wiener roast, and hayride.


