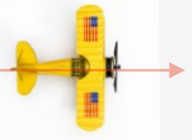

Frozen Thumb was a good time, and we had a very good turnout. Thanks to all that came out to make the event a success! And special thanks to all those who brought food and beverages.



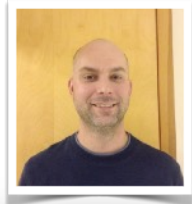
We will be gaining an hour of daylight in the evening this coming month, so get your favorite planes ready to head out to the field.

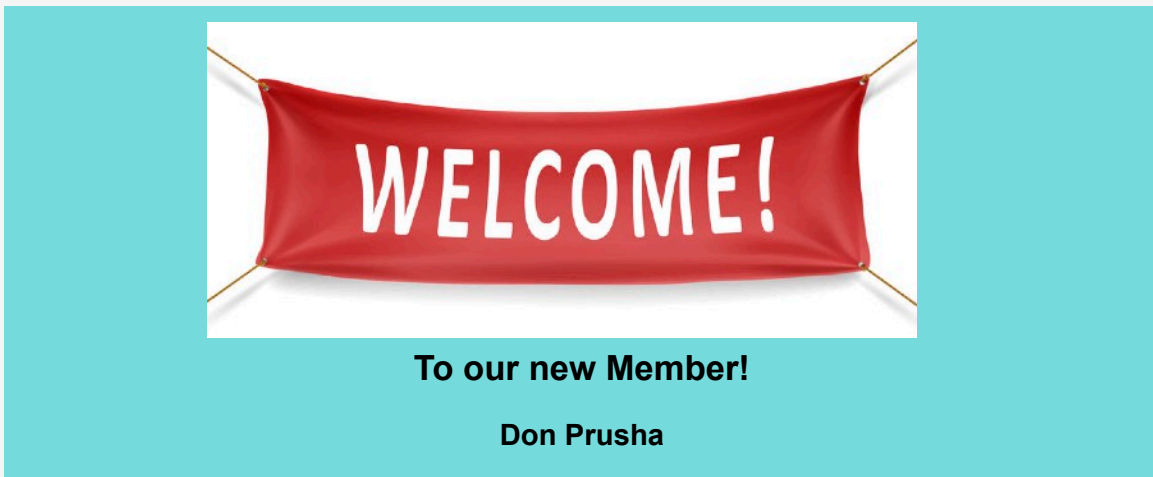
