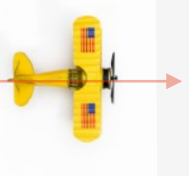

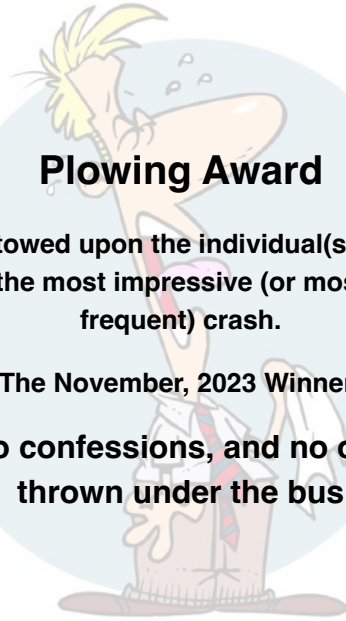
**Old Business:** Todd reported that as of right now we can plan on using our field for the 2024 season.

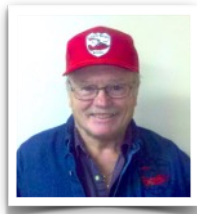
