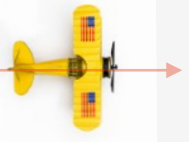

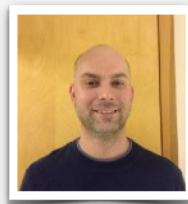

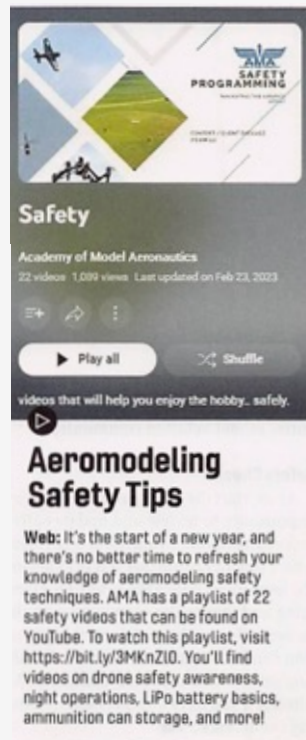

Due to weather the January meeting was not held. See you on the 8th of February!



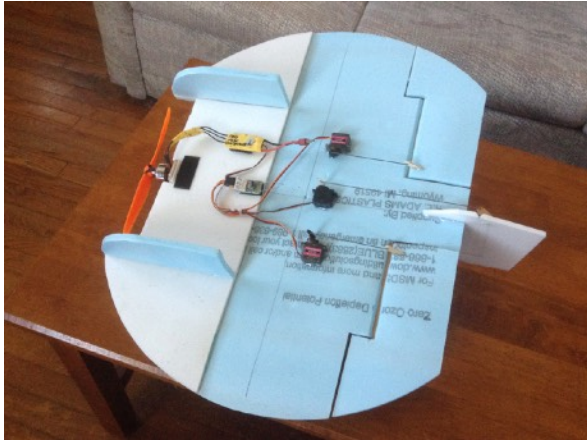
